

Saskatchewan Cancer Agency Physician Opportunities

MEDICAL ONCOLOGISTS

The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency is looking for medical oncologists to join our multi-disciplinary teams at both the Saskatoon Cancer Centre and Allan Blair Cancer Centre (Regina). The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency operates two comprehensive cancer treatment and research centres serving a population of one million.

The seven medical oncologists in each centre work with a multidisciplinary team of nurses, radiation oncologists, pediatric oncologists, gynecologic oncologists, surgeons, pharmacists, social workers, volunteers, a lay advisory group and a palliative care team to provide safe, patient-centered care. Cancer care is extended to surrounding communities by our medical oncologists, nurses and pharmacists through our Community Oncology Program. Participation in clinical trials in collaboration with NCCTG, NCIC, COG and RTOG is a major focus of activity for our oncologists in addition to teaching medical students and postgraduate residents enrolled at the College of Medicine of the University of Saskatchewan. Medical oncologists receive an academic appointment in the Division of Oncology, College of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan and privileges in the Department of Cancer Services at either the Pasqua Hospital in Regina or the Royal University Hospital in Saskatoon.

Saskatchewan is a growing prosperous province where you can build a career and raise a family. With a low cost of living, excellent recreational opportunities, a wealth of arts and culture, excellent elementary to post secondary education systems you'll find a warm Saskatchewan welcome and an incredible quality of life throughout the province.

Preference will be given to applicants who are certified in Medical Oncology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, but applicants with equivalent foreign qualifications will be considered. Successful applicants must be in good standing with their local regulatory bodies, and will need to be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan. In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.
