The Regional Cancer Program (RCP) of the Hôpital régional de Sudbury Regional Hospital (HRSRH) is seeking a **Medical Oncologist/ Haematologist**, to join its growing program.

The Program provides systemic treatment, radiation treatment, clinical research and supportive care to a catchment population of over 600,000 residents in Northeastern Ontario. You will join a team of 5 medical oncologists and 7 radiation oncologists treating a variety of haematologic malignancies and solid tumors.

You will enjoy a collaborative work environment in a multidisciplinary clinic environment with a state-of-the-art chemotherapy suite and dedicated inpatient oncology/palliative care beds.

Candidates also have the opportunity to be actively involved in teaching and research with the new Northern Ontario School of Medicine.

Sudbury is a scenic 4-hour drive north of Toronto, near spectacular Georgian Bay and the Muskoka region (www.city.greatersudbury.on.ca). The HRSRH is building a state-of-the-art one-site facility that will be completed by Spring 2010.

Applicants with an FRCP(C) in Internal Medicine or equivalent and a minimum of two years subspecialty training in Medical Oncology or Haematology are welcome to apply. A strong clinical background is required and experience in clinical research desirable.
