Practice Location(s): Allan Blair Cancer Centre, 4101 Dewdney Ave, Regina, SK, CA S4T 7T1

Population Base: The population of Saskatchewan is 1.16 million. The Allan Blair Cancer Centre provides comprehensive cancer care to those living in the southern part of the province.

Job Duties: The Saskatchewan Cancer Agency is looking for a locum medical oncologist in Regina for a 6 month term. Cancer Agency medical oncologists provide care as members of teams, which include nurses, pharmacists, radiation therapists, oncologists, clinical associates, general practitioners in oncology, surgeons, social workers, volunteers, patient advisors, and palliative care staff. Cancer care is extended to surrounding communities through the Community Oncology Program of Saskatchewan. Oncologists are supported by clinical associates for inpatient and on-call responsibilities.

Job Requirements:

Education:

- Degree in Medicine with subspecialty training in internal medicine and medical oncology .
- Preferred candidates will have obtained certification in internal medicine and medical oncology with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or have equivalent education, training and experience.

Experience:

- No experience required, but considered an asset.

Credentials:

- Must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.
- Must be eligible for membership and privileges with the Saskatchewan Health Authority in Regina.

Other:

- Eligible for Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) coverage or equivalent
- Criminal record check
- Written and verbal fluency in English
